RELEASE OF RIGHTS

The State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation, with a principal office at 7 Hazen Drive, Concord, New Hampshire 03302-0483, hereby releases to the State of New Hampshire Fish and Game Department, with a principal office at 11 Hazen Drive, Concord, New Hampshire 03301, certain rights to a parcel of land in Randolph described below, which the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation may have as a result of said premises formerly being owned by the Boston and Maine Corporation:

The right to extract gravel from a certain tract or parcel of land located in Randolph, County of Coos, State of New Hampshire, as shown on a plan entitled "Right of Way and Track Map, Concord & Montreal Railroad" and numbered V. 24.2/20 dated June 30, 1914 and on file at the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, Bureau of Rail and Transit. Said parcel is described as follows:

Parcel #4 on Railroad Right of Way and Track Map V. 24.2 Map 20, dated June 30, 1914, said Parcel #4 being located adjacent to the railroad corridor owned by the New Hampshire Department of Transportation between engineering station 1047+81 and engineering station 1054+34, said parcel being 148.5 feet in width and 450 feet in length at its northerly boundary and 653 feet in length at its southerly boundary adjacent to the railroad corridor owned by the New Hampshire Department of Transportation.

Meaning and intending to describe a portion of the premises conveyed to the New Hampshire Department of Transportation in a certain deed of the New Hampshire and Vermont Railroad Company to the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, dated January 15, 1998, and recorded January 21, 1998 at Book 887, Page 942 of the Coos County Registry of Deeds.

This conveyance is made subject to and with the benefit of all easements, conditions and restrictions as contained in a certain deed of the New Hampshire and Vermont Railroad Company to the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, dated January 15, 1998, and recorded January 21, 1998 at Book 887, Page 942 of the Coos County Registry of Deeds. This conveyance is also made subject to any easements and restrictions of record.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department, its successors and assigns, forever.
