REPORT

By this unopposed petition filed August 2, 1954, the Public Service Company of New Hampshire, an electric public utility operating under the jurisdiction of this Commission, seeks a license, pursuant to R. L. c. 294, 25. 17-20, to construct and maintain a transmission line over and across the Bellany River in Dover.

At the hearing on the petition held, following due notice, in Concord on September 15, 1954, the petitioner represented that the proposed 115 KV crossing, one of approximately 560 feet, with a minimum clearance of not less than 56 feet above mean high water, is necessary to transmit electricity generated at its Schiller Station in Portsmouth to its Manchester load area.

Upon investigation and consideration, this Commission finds that the construction proposed is necessary in order to meet the reasonable requirements of service to the public, and that the license sought herein may be exercised without substantially affecting the public rights in said waters.

This Commission hereby renders judgment granting the license herein petitioned for. Our order will issue accordingly.
