Hey Jasmin,

We anticipate roughly 5+ acres of area that will be disturbed and require restoration within WMNF.

For temporary stabilization during construction, we propose weed-free straw mulching areas to prevent erosion and allowing them to revegetate from the native seed bank. When performing final restoration activities, matting will be removed from the interior of WMNF towards the outward entry roads. During this process we would like to add an approved seed to assist with stabilization, as needed. Once matting is removed it will be very difficult to revisit areas to add seed as equipment will no longer be able to access the ROW. We would utilize the NE Wetland Plants, Inc. mixes that were recommended.

We can certainly discuss more during the next site visit, tentatively in late February, but please let me know if there are any questions in the meantime with the proposed approach.

Hi Ashley, I sent the proposed seed mix info to Dan and Catherine and received the response below. Please provide additional context and/or any further questions I can relay back to the Botany team. Thanks!

The proposed seed mix is not ideal as it contains all non-native seed; our S&Gs call for using native

seed as much as possible. Since there is very little non-native presence in the powerline to begin with, it would be good to keep it that way, so in this context I can't endorse that seed mix. My recommendations may depend on the individual situations. And it would be helpful to have some additional context. For example:

- Do they have an estimate how much area will be disturbed (ie ft2 or acreage) and potentially need revegetation?
- And how much of these areas consist of disturbed native soil material vs new material brought in?
- How much on steep ground where quick establishment may be needed? I think Kristi/Maddy might want to weigh in on what kind of slopes really require seeding vs. potentially just letting native seed bank do its thing.

In general, our default with native soil material revegetation, and areas that are relatively small, is to let native seed bank do the revegetation on its own, perhaps with some non-persistent annual like winter rye just to get something established quickly. If the disturbance is really heavy — ie deep churning of native soil material — vs just relatively light surface soil scarification, we might want to seed with a mix.

If we are talking B112 only, since it is happening entirely during the winter, I don't think we want to seed any disturbed wetlands since they should regrow, and since they should be fairly protected by the platforms – but yes, maybe straw for erosion control? The uplands depends on the questions above, in part.

In situations where we think we need or want to reseed, and if we aren't talking about huge acreage, they could use these mixes from NE Wetland Plants, Inc – such as Logging Road Mix or the Dry site mix. These mixes use either no perennial non-natives, or only small amounts to help establish a light matrix to increase the success of establishment of the native species.

I think we would have more context and better recommendations if we review the areas in the spring after they are finished and finalize recommendations then. If that is not feasible, they should go with one of the mixes from NE Wetland Plants or approved alternative with native seed.

I was able to get the seed mix the contractor is proposing for restoration, attached. This is used in uplands and the wetlands are mulched for stabilization and allow the native seed bank to revegetate. Please share with Christine and let us know if there are any questions on the selection.

As far as timing for a site visit at structure 78 right now we're looking at end of February. We'll stay in touch as we get closer to lock in a date.
