Hi Fred,

Thanks for your call from a few weeks back about the Eversource B112 Line Rebuild Project. Below are the questions I asked Eversource, and their response is in red:

- For access improvements along Kiah Pond Road, where are they getting their fill
 material from? Hopefully not the gravel under the powerlines since they're
 contaminated with lead casings. Material will not be removed from the ROW
 (including the shooting area between Kiah Pond Rd and Sandwich Notch Road)
 to improve Kiah Pond Road.
- Will there be any road improvements along Algonquin Road near the junction at Lower Hall Pond Rd? Algonquin Road will be maintained by the contractor throughout the course of the project. Upon completion, the road will be left in as-good-as or better condition as that which existed prior to project-use. Any improvements to the road will need to be approved by the underlying property owner.
- Are there Restoration Reports that will be filed periodically with NHDES as the
 project progresses? Project areas are routinely monitored by a third-party
 consultant to ensure compliance with environmental regulations and permit
 conditions. NHDES will be provided weekly construction monitoring reports.
