Captain Eastman,
Good afternoon.

The railroad corridor from Canterbury to Tilton is seeing a lot of snowmobiles trespassing on NHDOT property from a report by our local railroad operator. As you may know this line is now an active railroad year round and along with trespassing, also very dangerous to be recreating on an active railroad line. Appears a lot are getting on/off at the Sargent Street crossing in Northfield and also at the McDonalds in Tilton.

Although the line was recently plowed by our operator, the trespassing packs the remaining snow into the railroad components at the switches (making maintenance difficult) and also damages our bridge cross timbers as they now don't have any snowmobile track cleat protection.

The NH Division of Parks and Recreation has posted each intersection with no snowmobiling signs and the trail was removed from the NH snowmobiling map.

Requesting NH F&G enforcement assistance.
