Clements, Commissioner of Public Works and Highways, pursuant to vote of the Governor and Council on June 30, 1981, and in accordance with the provisions of New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Chapter 21-E:18, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars and other valuable consideration, to it in hand before the delivery hereof, well and truly paid by Public Service Company of New Hampshire, whose address is 1000 Elm Street, City of Manchester, County of Hillsborough, State of New Hampshire, has remised, released, and forever Quitclaimed, and by these presents, does remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said Public Service Company of New Hampshire, its survivors, its heirs and assigns forever:

Any and all interest the State of New Hampshire has in a small, pieshaped parcel of land located Southwesterly of, but not adjacent to, Bridge Street, so called, in the Town of Colebrook, County of Coos, State of New Hampshire, bounded and described as follows:
