

Dear Mr. Gomes:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your *Wetlands Minimum Impact Trails Notification*" for work in Stark, Tax Map/Lot #: 408 / 80-05, 91.

YOUR NOTICE IS SUFFICIENT TO START WORK PROVIDED:

You are NOT working in or adjacent to a municipally designated prime wetland, or in a bog, marsh, or undisturbed tidal buffer zone;

- 1. You are not constructing a trail for current or future development;
- 2. You follow the Best Management Practices for Erosion Control During Trail Maintenance and Construction (2004) published by the Dept. of Resources & Economic Development;
- 3. Each wetland crossing involves less than 3,000 square feet of impact;
- 4. Your proposed trail does not cross any stream 8 or more feet wide [or as allowed by Administrative Rule Env-Wt 303.04(h)].
- 5. You have avoided wetlands and stream crossings where possible; all crossings have been located to minimize impacts; and all crossings qualify as minimum impact by NHDES Wetlands Bureau rules; and
- 6. Written permission of the landowner shall be obtained prior to work at any locality. This notice does not convey property right, nor authorize any injury to the property of others, nor invasion of the rights of others.
- 7. The trail project must fully comply with the Permit by Rule requirements of NH Administrative Rule Env-Wq 1503.03(c) or (d) under the Alteration of Terrain Bureau.

Project Description:

New 90' long bridge over Nash Stream with concrete

block abutments set back 10' from the bank on each side. Two culverts in east approach trail for cross trail drainage.

The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.

A negative result (no record in our database) does not mean that a sensitive species is not present. Our data can only tell you of known occurrences, based on information gathered by qualified biologists and reported to our office. However, many areas have never been surveyed, or have only been surveyed for certain species. An on-site survey would provide better information on what species and communities are indeed present.
