Background

- Multiple states allow All-Terrain Vehicles & Utility-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs & UTVs) to operate on public roads under certain circumstances
 - ATVs = 3 wheels, UTVs (aka "side-by-sides") =
 4 wheels
 - Gas-powered vehicles designed for rough terrain and can go up to 45 mph
- MUTCD does not address ATVs, except as a recreational symbol in Part 2M

Snowmobile Signing in MUTCD

- ATVs and Snowmobiles (IMHO) have similar operational characteristics and signing needs
 - Not proposing to address golf cart or other "weird vehicle" signs at this time
- Current snowmobile signing in MUTCD
 - Warning sign in Section 2C.50 (Non-Vehicular Warning Signs)
 - No regulatory or guide signing
- NPA has proposed to add R9-15 "No Snowmobiles" sign







VDOT approach

- Governed by §46.2-800.2 of Code of Virginia
 - Limited to far southwestern VA (near KY/TN/WV borders)
 - Mostly limited to 25 mph roads, but some exceptions
 - Code requires VDOT to install warning signage
- ATV signs used by VDOT









PennDOT approach


