
Thank you for your letter of June 13, 2018 regarding the above referenced Transportation Enhancement (TE) program grant. In your letter, you requested copies of all Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) documents that were provided to the Town of Haverhill and the State of New Hampshire as part of the grant application and award process.

The Federal-aid Highway Program is a federally-assisted program of State-selected projects.
