Thank you all for staying late last night to participate in the Nash Stream Citizen's Advisory Committee meeting. It was productive, informative and as always, slightly controversial.

Todd/Maggie – once you have the draft meeting notes, please circulate for review before we finalize.

I have spoken with Director Mason and informed him that NHFG was unrepresented. He regretted missing the meeting and that no one was available from his agency. (As we know, Jake Debow is away and they're still recruiting for Jill and John's replacement.)

I plan to call Corey Clark at DES to make the connection and share the feedback we received from camp owners and committee members about the dam reconstruction project. I will impress upon him the importance of DES conducting a public hearing *before* settling on a final design and access plan. It is not the role of DNCR-DFL to manage the public input process for this project.

A formal letter to DES co-signed by DNCR and NHFG expressing the importance of a public hearing can/may follow soon.
