PETITION FOR AUTHORITY TO INSTALL AUTOMATIC FLASHING LIGHT SIGNALS AT COTTAGE STREET CROSSING IN THE TOWN OF LITTLETON.

Crossings - Installation of automatic signals - Public safety.

1. A railroad was authorized to install double automatic signals at a crossing in a town, it appearing that such installation would provide greater safety, which would be in the public interest.

ORDER No. 5163

Whereas, the State Highway Commissioner and the Boston and Maine Railroad, by petition filed August 18, 1947, seek authority to install automatic flashing signals at a Railroad highway grade crossing known as Cottage Street Crossing, situated about 0.04 of a mile north of Littleton Station in the Town of Littleton; and

Whereas, said crossing is not now protected by any automatic device; and

Whereas, the Commission is of the opinion that the installation of said automatic signals will provide greater safety, which is manifestly in the public interest; and

Whereas, after notification to all parties interested, no objection to the proposed installation is made and parties concerned have waived hearing thereon; it is

Ordered, that the State Highway Commissioner and the Boston and Maine Railroad be, and hereby are, authorized to install automatic flashing signals at the Cottage Street Crossing, so-called, located at a point approximately 0.04 of a mile north of Littleton Station in the Town of Littleton.
