I commend you for drafting a clear, concise, useful master plan for the summit of Mt. Washington.

I encourage you to maintain and focus on these priorities for the Summit:

- 1. Careful and detailed assessments and protection of the alpine ecosystems
- 2. No new accommodations for human overnight stays on or near the summit (e.g., as proposed by the cog railway company)
- 3. Informed and planned management of the number of human visitors coming to the summit via the auto road, cog railway, and hiking trails
- 4. Sustainable management of all wastes and energy systems from operations at the summit. I encourage the use of heat pumps, solar panels on roofs, but not windmills or solar panels on the ground.
- 5. Careful planning to minimize the development of unsightly structures on the summit. This has been a major change since 1970, and not for the better.
