Dear Vince Vukelich,

your office failed to respond to documents and information which completely undermine the Gene Erl opinion that ATV use in Nash Stream State Forest is permitted under the terms of the Conservation Easement. These documents were not

a tedious argument of insidious intent, and they deserved a real response.

You did, however, respond to my follow-up email, the works and days of hands that lift and drop a question on your plate, and intended to lead you to an overwhelming question, To wonder, "Do I dare?" and, "Do I dare?" Do I dare Disturb the Agency? which you felt was criticism of your character.
