(Concord, NH) The Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Bureau of Trails announces a public meeting on Wednesday, May 22nd, 6:00pm at the Colebrook Elementary School to discuss including Off Highway Recreational Vehicles use on portions of NH Route 3 and NH Route 145.

The Bureau is seeking input on designation of the following sections of NH State Highway for OHRV use:

NH Rte 145, from Hughes Road north 1200'

NH Rte 3, from the access road to LaPerle's north 630' to a gravel access road to the recreational rail trail
