Hi Michele.

NHB had identified some historic rare plant areas in the ROW and during our initial planning and design we preemptively used upland matting to protect those areas. Once we reached the appropriate time of year for field surveys, and found no plants, we removed that protective matting in the AOT amendment since there was no need for it.

Please see the attached correspondence documenting NHB's concurrence with our findings and BMPs. Unfortunately, the rare plant report is considered confidential information by NHB and Eversource, so I can't just share it with you here, but you can contact Sabrina Stanwood
