Design of the RSP23

- RSP23 continues the streamlining efforts started with the RSP21 in response to stakeholder feedback
 - RSP21 contains a lot of numerical data and tables. In RSP23, more focus is placed on text and graphics
 - In place of tables, links to relevant portions of the website provide current information
 - Tables and data in the body of the RSP are contextualized whenever possible
 - An appendix with data that was used to build the graphics is included

Design of the 2023 RSP, cont.

- Further graphical enhancements will be made before the final version including “Regional Energy Outlook-esque” graphics in the Executive Summary
- The order of the RSP chapters has been changed in RSP23
- RSP23 builds on positive feedback from the FGRS report
