

Transmission Planning Process Guide – Needs Assessments – Rev. 1

Includes conforming changes resulting from October 2, 2015 Order

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Purpose

- Present updates to the Transmission Planning Process Guide (the Guide) to address:
 - Conforming Qualified Transmission Project Sponsor (QTPS) process changes resulting from the October 2, 2015, FERC Order
 - Changes and improvements to the description of the Needs
 Assessment portion of the Guide

Conforming Changes

- On October 2, 2015, FERC issued an Order requiring changes to the QTPS process in Section 4B of Attachment K to the OATT, which necessitate changes within the Guide
 - FERC had previously required that, in addition to meeting the evaluation criteria, a Participating Transmission Owners (PTO) had to be party to both the Transmission Operating Agreement (TOA) and a Non-Incumbent Transmission Developer Operating Agreement (NTDOA) in order to be granted QTPS status
 - Recognizing the addition of the hold harmless clause to the TOA,
 FERC eliminated the NTDOA requirement so that a PTO only has to be party to the TOA


Section 2.2 of the Guide was updated to reflect this revision

 Note: FERC did not modify the requirement that, in addition to meeting the evaluation criteria, a non-PTO has to be party to an NTDOA and a Market Participant Service Agreement in order to be granted QTPS status


Needs Assessment

- The Planning Guide has been updated to reflect:
 - The formation of study groups (ISO and affected equipment owners) no longer applies
 - The ISO now coordinates with the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC)
 to support the ISO's performance of Needs Assessments
 - Other process changes have been made to facilitate implementation
 - Initial cases are posted to reduce the amount of rework (more information is provided on this topic later in the presentation)


Prior Process



Current Process


ISO creates and posts initial study file(s) for PAC review and comment

- New step added to reduce rework
- One case is provided for topology review
- Once comments are received on that single case, numerous cases will be created to cover various dispatch and transfer scenarios to be included in the draft scope
- Adding this step prevents making changes to numerous cases





Process was reordered


 Prior process required a determination of whether the scope was complete prior to testing
