SNOWMOBILE TRAIL CONNECTOR PERMIT

Permission to maintain a snowmobile trail connector within the State owned right-of-way of 114 in the Town of Henniker pursuant to the location and specifications described below is hereby granted.

LOCATION: along Rte. 114 from Mink Hill Rd south to crossing to Rte 114; from N43.207962, W71.853526 to N43.206735, W71.851134.

- 1. Trail signs shall be erected to warn of highway traffic and of the necessity to remain on the designated trail connector at all times.
2. Travel is not permitted on the pavement, in front of mailboxes, or in an area where snow is plowed by the Department of Transportation.
3. Driveways are not to have snow deposited within or blocked.
4. No other portion of the highway right-of-way outside the designated trail connector and trail crossing is authorized for use.
5. The trail connector must be physically closed for the entire snowmobile off-season.
6. This snowmobile trail connector is to be within the state right-of-way / land and not to infringe on private property properties without owners consent.
7. All required fencing must be erected and maintained under the direction of the Bureau of Off Highway Vehicles.
8. No parking of motor vehicles and/or trailers used to transport snowmobiles, or any catering or servicing of any kind, shall be conducted within the highway right-of-way.
9. Snowmobile traffic is two-way on the connector and speed must be reasonable and safe as advised by the Bureau of Off Highway Vehicles.
10. The highway right-of-way line varies from 50 feet to approximately 175 feet from and parallel to the centerline of the highway pavement, see plan for more information.
