Good Morning Larry

I saw the email to Clint, which you copied me on. I guess this is in our court and we will route it like your request last year. As you remember last year this was not an event or request, for which there is an established permit or process.

Last year DOT and DOS set out a list of conditions under which they would allow the use 900 feet of the 30 MPH zone of Rte 3 and then use 650 feet of the existing snowmobile trail along the western side of Rte 3 to your store (thus keeping OHRV traffic off of road in the 50 MPH speed zone). We do wish that we had a little more notice for this Anniversary Bash and your desire to get an exemption for it this month.

We would expect that this would be the last request for special consideration for an event at your store and that you will have the trail from your store to the storage units completed for next season. We will be requesting the access for Saturday, September 28th only. If approved it would be daylight hours only.

I will follow up with DOT and DOS about the conditions they set for your event last year. The conditions for last year's Grand Opening were the following:

- No loading or unloading of OHRVs shall occur within the highway ROW;
- No motor vehicles, trailers or any catering or servicing equipment of any kind shall be parked within the highway right-of-way (ROW);
- OHRVs shall not have studded tires or tracks;
- Larry Meservey / MOMs shall be responsible for repairing any damage to the highway infrastructure that may occur as a result of this approval.

Oh-highway Connector:

- OHRVs must use paved travel lanes;
- OHRVs shall follow the rules of the road, including traveling in the direction of traffic, traveling in single file, obeying regulatory signage, and not traveling at speeds greater than the posted speed limit.

Off-highway Connector:

- Trail signs reading "STOP" shall be installed and maintained on the trail at or near the highway shoulder, and a sign warning of the stop ahead shall be installed on the trail at least 100 feet back from the highway.

I will need confirmation of support for the event from the Northumberland Police Department and Select Board. I would like that to be in writing (email or letter) and as soon as possible.

This ride will be stopping at local Groveton Businesses as well as listed properties along the trail system. It will end at MOMS for prizes and entertainment.
