Dear Director Bielecki and Mr. Rodrigue,

I see you are the NH DOT & DOS representatives on the HB 1182 committee to look at Off Road vehicle use on roads.

Do you have a copy of the Ride the Wilds OHRV Trail map? It seems important for the committee to have a clear understanding of just how many hundreds of miles of public road in Coos are opened as OHRV "trails" and a picture (i.e. map) is worth 1000 words.

I understand that there are approximately 50 miles of state road for OHRV travel w/ DOT/DOS approval, but many more miles of town roads have been opened, contrary to manufacturer recommendations that their machines not be used on paved roads.

I asked DNCR to detail how many miles of their Connector Trails - BOT State Corridors A,C,D- were state road, town road, public land, private land but they could not tell me.
