Dear Ms. Sheehan, Mr. Quinn and Mr. Haynes

As a NH resident, I would like to comment on four upcoming house bills.

- 1.) HB 1688 Speed limits of ATV's should be consistent with that of motor vehicles. I support this bill.
- 2.) HB 1427 I support this bill to remove authorization for ORHV use from certain sections of state highway, as residents were denied due process in the prior openings of some roads.
- 3.) HB 1156 This study to "minimize" use of public roads for OHRV is an error-in-the-making, and I oppose it. "OH", off-highway vehicles, should simply NOT be on roads. Even the manufacturers of these vehicles state that. Why not fund HB 660, signed by the Governor last year, creating funding for the studies on this that were approved?
- 4.) HB 1438 NO! Again, OHRV's do NOT belong on any public roads, divided or not! And this totally ignores all the abutting tax-payers, who may have their home's serenity totally destroyed by the noise and pollution of ATV usage on their roads.
