Denise,

Will you be in tomorrow morning so that I can give you a call to determine what you are looking for.

After we met last Fall, I thought I had a pretty good handle on what I was tasked to do, but as we discussed it internally, there were a number of questions. In November, we met internally, with Alex Belenz of North Country Council included, to brainstorm the alternatives. We came up with several hand drawn typical sections showing alternative lane configuration and pavement allocation for the five lane segment of the Berlin-Gorham Road. Alex was going to share those alternatives with you to get a better understanding of what the town was most interested in.

It was my understanding that the town was interested in a road diet that would make the road more attractive to pedestrians and bicyclists all the way to the Berlin line. Developing that graphic would be fairly involved. After speaking with Dave Rodrigue this afternoon, I get the impression that you are most interested in the segment up to where we met several months ago, within the existing 30 mph speed zone. While that also presents some challenges due to the width at the speed limit change, it is more manageable than the full length of the segment. If you are available, I can give you a call after 10:00 to discuss.
