## QUITCLAIM

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT, The State of New Hampshire, by Wallace E. Stickney, Commissioner of The State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation, pursuant to vote of the Governor and Council on October 12, 1988, and in accordance with the provisions of New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated 228:31, for and in consideration of the sum of eleven thousand seven hundred (\$11,700.00) dollars, to it in hand before the delivery hereof, well and truly paid by Paul W. Dumont d/b/a Duco Sales of 51 Lehner Street, Town of Wolfeboro, County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, has remised, released, and forever QUITCLAIMED, and by these presents, does remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto said Paul W. Dumont d/b/a Duco Sales, his heirs and assigns forever:

Any and all interest The State of New Hampshire has in a certain tract of land on the Northerly side of the State-owned Wolfeboro Railroad, as now traveled, in the Town of Wolfeboro, County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, bounded and described as follows:

Being all the land belonging to The State of New Hampshire that is Northerly of a line that is sixteen and one-half (16.5) feet Northerly of and parallel with the main track Centerline near Station 611+00 as shown on Railroad Valuation V 4.6/13, on file in the records of The State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation; bounded on the West by the Easterly Right-of-Way of Routes 28 and 109, as now traveled; bounded on the North and East by other land of Paul Dumont, bounded on the South by a line that is sixteen and one-half (16.5) feet Northerly of and parallel with said main track Centerline.

Containing three thousand twenty-five (3,025) square feet, more or less, and being a portion of those premises conveyed to The State of New Hampshire by the Wolfeboro Railroad Company, Inc. and recorded in the Carroll County Registry of Deeds on August 12, 1986, Book 1127, Page 310.

The above-described conveyance shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1) A physical barrier, such as a chain link fence or guard rail, that is acceptable to the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportion's Bureau of Railroads is to be constructed and maintained at the grantee's expense to deliniate the new property line of The State-owned Wolfeboro Railroad and the above-described conveyance.
- 2) Also reserving the right of The State of New Hampshire to clear and keep clear any growth or other obstruction that may interfere with the site line as shown on the above-mentioned railroad valuation:

Beginning at a point in the Easterly Sideline of Routes 28 and 109, as now traveled, in the Town of Wolfeboro, said point being sixteen and one-half (16.5) Northerly of the main track Center Line of the State-owned Wolfeboro Railroad; thence Easterly and parallel with said main track tenter Line a distance of fifty (50) feet; thence Northwesterly a distance of fifty (50) feet to a point in the Easterly Sideline of Routes 28 and 109, as now traveled, thence Southeasterly a distance of forty-three (43) feet, more or less, with said Easterly Sideline to the point of beginning.

The Grantee, its successors in interest and assigns, as part of the consideration hereof, does hereby covenant and agree that as a covenant running with the land, (1) no person on the ground of race, color, handicap, sex, or national origin shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in use of said facilities, (2) that in the construction of any improvements on, over or under such land and the furnishing of services thereon, no person on the ground of race, color, handicap, sex or national origin shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination, and (3) that the Grantee shall use the premises in compliance with all other requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle "A", Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Non-Discrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation, Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and as said regulations may be amended.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Grantee, his heirs, and assigns forever:
